Respect the peace of nature.

On the shore, leave room for other people as well.







Give way to other water traffic. Avoid paddling on boat routes.

Take your rubbish with you. Use only dedicated spots for campfires. Open fires are forbidden when a forest fire warning is in effect.





Familiarize yourself with bird nesting areas and nature conservation areas. Obey their rules.

Use marked spots for landing ashore.

Avoid residential areas when paddling or landing.



Always use a life vest. Keep a phone with you with the 112 emergency call application installed. Only paddle under conditions in which you can maintain control.
